The NAP Readiness Project

Title: Enhancing Capacity for Planning & Effective Implementation of CCA in Kenya

Type of readiness support: National adaptation planning.

Funding Level: USD 3 Million

Duration: 3 years (2019-2021).

Status: *Currently being implemented*



Expected Results: UN CC:Learn project

- ❑ Climate change learning and skills development needs identified and integrated in ongoing capacity development programs;
- ❑ Sustainable approaches for climate change learning developed;
- ❑ Climate change learning actions implemented;

UN CC:Learn Funding level: USD 107,000.

NAP Readiness Funding level: USD 3 Million

Expected Results: NAP Readiness project

- ❑ Technical and institutional capacities for adaptation planning and implementation in key Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) enhanced.
- ❑ Knowledge base for adaptation strengthened.
- ❑ Evidence-base for climate change adaptation in agriculture improved and integrated in subsequent National Adaptation Plans.
- ❑ Private sector actively engaged and investing in the adaptation process.



Links: UN CC:Learn project

- 1) Conduct a **Training and Needs Assessment** (TNA) in climate sensitive sectors;
- 2) Develop a **National CC Learning Strategy**;
- 3) Implement recommended actions aimed at **skills enhancement**.

NAP Readiness project

- 1) Conduct a **capacity needs assessment** for climate change adaptation planning in key sectors.
- 2) Based on 1, develop a **Climate Change curriculum** to be integrated in the Kenya School of Government training programmes.
- 3) **Train at least 500 government officers** in Climate Change Units at the sub-national level.



Other possible areas for Collaboration

Under component II of the NAP Readiness project

- i. Develop a regional climate change training programme for journalists
- ii. Training for journalists on climate change
- iii. Establish a regional knowledge hub for adaptation (initially, Kenya, Uganda and Ethiopia)

Under component IV of the NAP Readiness project

- i. Private sector engagement in climate action
