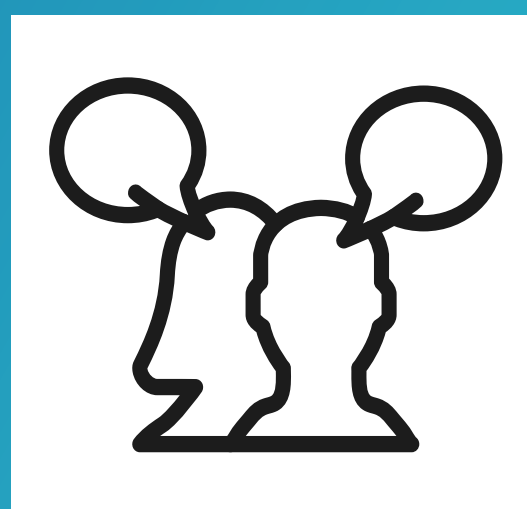
## E-Learning Courses

A variety of climate change and green economy-related e-courses available free of charge through a mobile-friendly online platform.



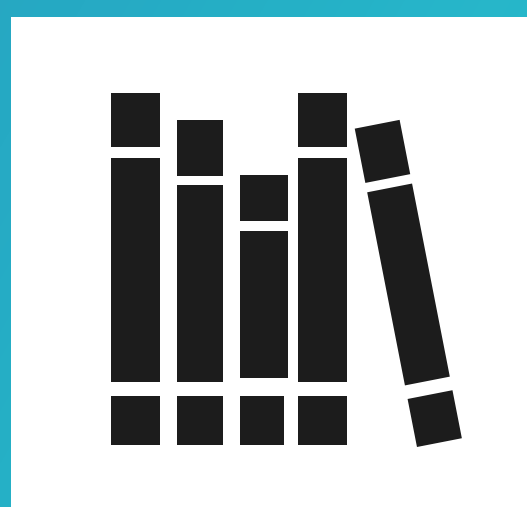
## In-Country Projects
